## “Future Prospect Reward Guidelines”

1. In order to cultivate excellent students to study abroad for future prospect, and contribute what they’ve learned to school, society and country, Fooyin University (hereinafter referred to as “the University”) stipulates these key points in accordance with Article 3 of Implementation Methods for the University’s Student Scholarship.
2. Objects of the rewards: Students who research and study in overseas colleges for more than two weeks.
3. Applicants’ qualifications: Students at the University who have official enrolment and have studied for more than one semester, excluding super seniors, further study promotional students and in-service education program students. Overseas students shall not apply for schools in home countries and within the territory.
4. Application conditions:
  - (1) Department ranking within the top 10%;
  - (2) Overall average of conduct over the years exceeds 80 scores, without any punishment records at school.
  - (3) Foreign language proficiency must meet one of the following conditions:
    - a. English: TOEIC achievement over 500 scores
    - b. Japanese (must study in Japan area): be qualified for JLPT N3 level
  - (4) Special and excellent performance should be recommended by college & department.
5. Rewards: Maximum limit of NT\$ 60,000 each person
6. The applicants should submit the following documents to each department and institute two months prior to research and study, which should be summarized to Research and Development Office upon review and consent of the recommendation. Incomplete documents shall not be handled.
  - (1) Application form (attachment 1)
  - (2) Copied foreign language proficiency certificate
  - (3) Copied Chinese transcript at school over the years, noted with class/department & institute ranking percentage
  - (4) Chinese/English autobiography and research & study proposal (attachment 2)
  - (5) Two reference letters (attachment 3)
  - (6) Other documents with highlights during the semester in favor of review

7. Review methods: It's reviewed by the University's International Development Committee, on written review basis, and applicants shall be invited to interview as required.
8. Rewards and quotas shall depend on the budget prepared by Student Scholarship Committee.
9. The funds as required for the rewards shall be prepared in annual budget by Student Scholarship Committee.
10. After receiving official notice, anyone awarded shall submit the following documents to Research and Development Office for reimbursement in addition to completing his/her own procedure for processing abroad. Any delay shall be deemed as abandonment.
  - (1) Exit declaration form
  - (2) Reimbursement application form
  - (3) Consent certificate for research & study issued by foreign schools or institutions
  - (4) Administrative agreement for studying and researching abroad
  - (5) Letter of parents' consent
11. A study feedback report (more than 3000 words) should be submitted, and the outcome presentation be attended within one month after entry
12. If anyone being approved for subsidy may return to one's country during the reward period, one shall obtain prior consent from the University, and the amount of subsidy for days of returning shall be deducted in proportion. Anyone who may directly apply for suspension, drop-out and delayed returning shall return all rewards.
13. Upon being passed in administrative conference, these regulations shall be released for implementation after president approval; amendment thereof shall be applicable.
