

Fooyin University Rewards Guidelines for Excellent Foreign Students

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1. These regulations are established to encourage excellent foreign students to study at the University in accordance with Article 3 of “Student Scholarship Implementation Methods”.
2. Objects of the rewards: Anyone who applies for studying at the University as identity of foreign students in accordance with the University’s “Admission Requirements for Foreign Students” shall be degree-seeking students with an official enrollment in the University (excluding super seniors), and subject to confirmation of Office of International and Cross-strait Affairs.
3. Qualifications required and reward contents:
 - (1) Freshmen:
 - a. General freshmen: According to the University’s “Admission Requirements for Foreign Students”, anyone who applies for studying at the University as identity of foreign student and meets admission qualification to be enrolled upon Admission Committee’s review shall be provided with rewards equivalent to the tuition and fees of the first semester. After the enrollment, student’s total credits for the first semester should meet the University’s requirements without any course failure and any punishment records above demerits, and rewards equivalent to the tuition and fees of the second semester shall be continued to offer. Freshmen in Two-Year Undergraduate Program and MS Program shall be provided with rewards equivalent to the tuition and fees of the first semester.
 - b. In-Service master degree program freshmen: Anyone being approved to be provided with rewards equivalent to the tuition and fees of the first semester shall be handled by referring to old students for the second semester.
 - c. Transferred freshmen: Anyone who enrolls in the University according to transfer requirements shall be approved to be provided with rewards equivalent to the tuition and fees of the current semester, and be handled by referring to old students for the next semester.
 - (2) Old students: Degree-seeking foreign students studying at the University (excluding super seniors and in-service mater degree program students) for more than one year (studying at Two-Year Undergraduate Program and MS Program for a full semester) and having official enrollment meets the following requirements:
 - a. Rewards of tuition and fees waiver, tuition waiver and fees waiver should be respectively offered according to academic performance in school;

- b. Rewards for the current year's graduates in the last semester shall not be offered;
- c. The aforesaid students' total credits should meet school requirements without any course failure and any punishment records above demerits.

4. Approval for issuance:

- (1) Freshmen: Anyone being registered for entrance in Taiwan shall be in the reward list presented by Office of International and Cross-Strait Affairs and approved by President Chen.
- (2) Old students: Student's transcript (including conduct performance) in the previous semester offered by Office of Academic Affairs and certificate for no punishment records above demerits by Office of Student Affairs should be registered as mentioned above by Office of International and Cross-Strait Affairs before the University may review to approve amount and quota for the current semester's scholarship depending on budget and fund.

5. Principles of rewards:

- (1) Any student being rewarded should participate in service learning activity for 20~90 hours per semester arranged by Office of International and Cross-Strait Affairs during the period of school. His/her service learning outcome will be listed for reference in the next approval. Hour distribution is as follows:
Freshmen: Anyone being provided with tuition and fees waiver each semester in the first semester is responsible for 90 hours of service;
Old students:
Tuition and fees waiver for 60 hours of service.
Tuition waiver for 40 hours of service.
Fees waiver for 20 hours of service.
 - (2) If any student being rewarded may apply for suspension or reserving enrollment, the original approved scholarship qualification shall be cancelled. Such qualification shall be reapplied for during the specified application period in the current semester of re-enrolling.
 - (3) If any student being rewarded may hold residence permit with identity of "employment" or visa with "job" after registering for entrance, he/she only can apply for subsidy of tuition waiver.
 - (4) If any student being rewarded may violate the University's school regulations, be punished above demerits, or receive the reward by forging and faking qualification, his/her qualification shall be cancelled and the rewards having been received shall be returned.
 - (5) If any student being rewarded may apply for transferring midway or suspension or drop-out, his/her reward having been received in the current semester shall be recovered.
6. The funds required for the reward shall be prepared from the University's scholarship budget.
7. Upon being passed in administrative conference, these regulations shall be released for implementation after president approval; amendment thereof shall be applicable.
